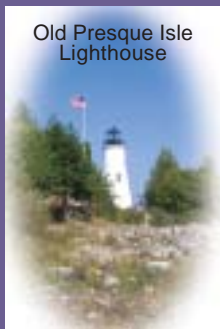

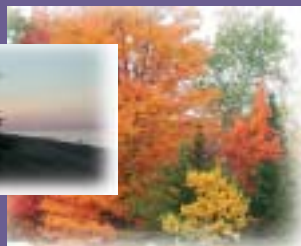
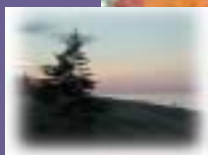

- The Ontonagon Harbor Lighthouse is the westernmost lighthouse in all of Michigan and also the oldest lighthouse structure on the mainland of the Keweenaw.
- Built in 1866 to replace an earlier wooden structure that dated from 1851, the current building is of the "school house" design and constructed of Milwaukee "Cream City" brick.
- Nine keepers in all watched over the Ontonagon Harbor Lighthouse. The fourth keeper, Thomas Stripe, was the first to work in the current structure. The last keeper, Arnold Huuki, served until the light was decommissioned on January 1, 1964.
- After a ten year effort, the lighthouse was transferred to the Historical Society in 2003, and the restoration efforts of the group been ongoing since that time.
