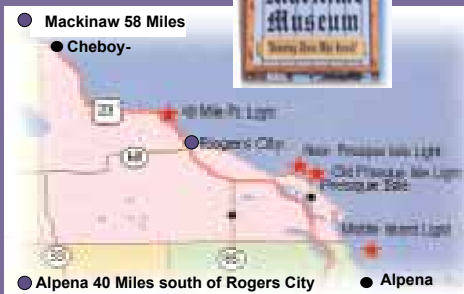

* At one time, this was one of the most endangered lights on the lakes. Storms had bitten a full corner out of the keeper's quarters and the elements threatened to wreck the site.

* The lighthouse was built in 1895 at a cost of \$15,000.00 under the supervision of Frank Rounds from Detroit. It was commissioned on May 15, 1896. In 1924 the beacon was automat- ed, and in 1947 the lighthouse was deactivated.

* On the first floor, most of the original machinery for operation of the lighthouse and foghorn were removed for scrap to support WWII efforts. The second and third floors provided living qtrs for the lighthouse keepers and their families during the shipping season.

* Today the site and the 378 acre island are overseen by the U.S. Forest Service, Hiawatha National Forest. Lake Huron Area Council Boy Scout Troop 323 of Freeland, MI assist with summer clean-up activities and repairs, co-host the OPEN HOUSE and provide guided tours.
